Outstanding Issues

New Issues

The following reported problems have been found and are still outstanding in this release.

MPOW-122	<i>mPower</i> HTTPS server is affected by CVE-2022-0778	1.0.2	Deferred
MPOW-120	Range checking is missing from some <i>mPower</i> settings	1.0.2	Deferred
MPOW-115	<i>mPower</i> does not reinstall properly	1.0.2	Deferred
MPOW-17	Power data is not included from 3-Phase UPSes	1.0.2	Deferred
MPOW-86	<i>mPower</i> repeats automatic logout messages	1.0.2	Deferred

MPOW-122 *mPower* HTTPS server is affected by CVE-2022-0778

This may prevent *mPower* from updating data from managed devices.

Workaround: None

MPOW-120 Range checking is missing from some *mPower* settings

Some settings may be entered as text instead of numbers, this will cause the function to misoperate.

Workaround: None

MPOW-115 *mPower* does not reinstall properly

If the *mPower* service is already running and the installer is run again, the installer is unable to replace the existing executable.

Workaround: Uninstall *mPower* before reinstalling

MPOW-17 Power data is not included from 3-Phase UPSes

If *mPower* is connected to 3-Phase UPSes, it does not properly average the phase power output. The result is the Dashboard average power output is only for 1-Phase UPSes.

Workaround: None

MPOW-86 *mPower* repeats automatic logout messages

When the browser is closed without logging out from *mPower*, *mPower* will automatically close the session upon the set timeout. It will then repeat the session timeout message every hour.

Workaround: Logout before closing *mPower*
